There really aren't enough words to express our sincere appreciation for the telethon you and your team conducted on October 7, 2015 to help with the floods. The flood waters were still rising in the lower part of the state, and you knew that we would need financial support to help our residents in harms' way. Thanks to you and the team at WYFF, we raised \$830,519! This includes several corporate gifts as well as an individual donor who gave \$100,000. Even after being on the air for 16 hours, the twelve phones that we had available would not stop ringing! Our volunteers stayed an extra hour answering phones until we all gave out. Then you were kind enough to continue to give your viewers an opportunity to give if they could not get through during the telethon. We received a huge spike in our online donations during your airtime and the day after totaling over \$85,000!!!

The power of your television reach and the mission of the Red Cross to provide immediate, emergency relief resulted in the most successful telethon in our area in recent years. In fact, we have now worked with you and WYFF since Hurricane Hugo, 25 years ago to hold eight telethons and raise \$3,325,073. That is truly amazing.

Your willingness to do these telethons means that thousands of people received a hot meal, something to drink, a clean-up kit or a comfort kit filled with hygiene items and toys for children. They were met with a Red Cross mental health worker who helped them sort through their emotions and fears.
